Thirty-Sixth Legislature of the Virgin Islands

An act amending title 33 Virgin Islands Code, subtitle 3, chapter 113, section 3109(b) to require that violations committed by officers or employees of any governmental agency be reported to the Attorney General of the Virgin Islands for investigation and prosecution

PROPOSED BY: Senator Carla J. Joseph

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Virgin Islands:

SECTION 1. Title 33 Virgin Islands Code, subtitle 3, chapter 113, section 3109(b) is amended by striking “Governor, through the Director of the Office of Management and Budget,” and inserting “Attorney General of the Virgin Islands for investigation and prosecution, if warranted.”

BILL SUMMARY

This bill amends title 33 of the Virgin Islands Code, subtitle 3, chapter 113, section 3109(b) by removing the requirement for agency heads to report violations to the Governor through the Director of the Office of Management and Budget and instead reporting violations to the Attorney General of the Virgin Islands.
