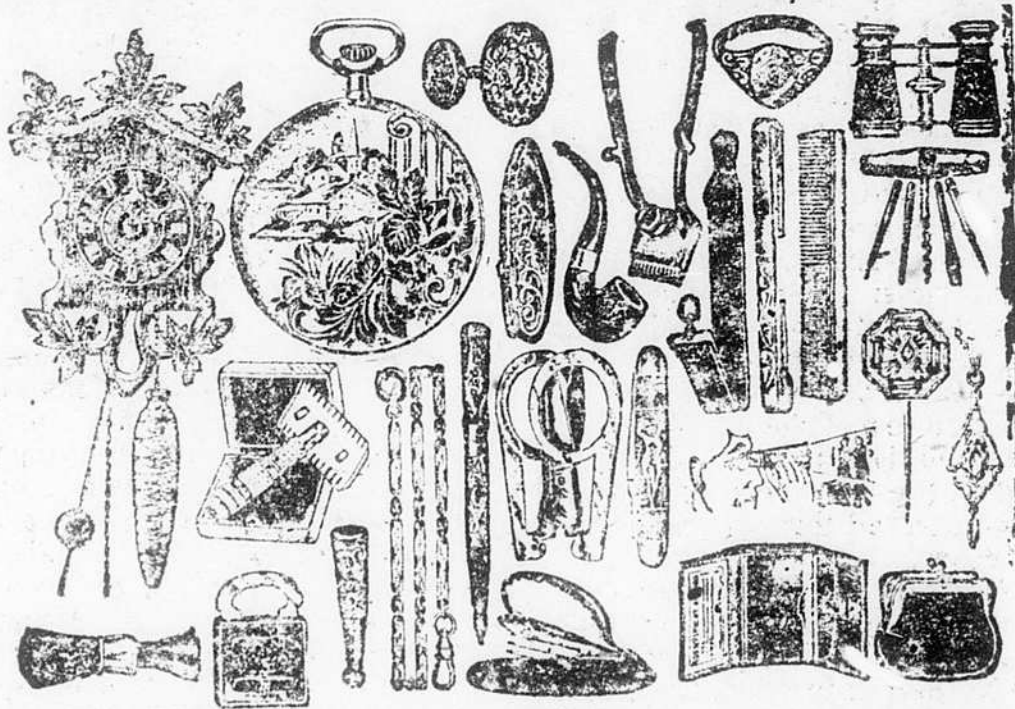

## TELEGRAMS.

### ST. CROIX STATION.

Coblenz, Nov. 4th.—A protest against the British attitude toward the Separatists in the Cologne area was sent by Joseph Matthes to Lord Kilmarnock, member of the Rhineland High Commission, but the communication was returned unopened. Matthes announced today that he would take further action to show the resentment of the Separatists against the attitude of the British. One Separatist in Cologne already has been sentenced to four months' imprisonment by the British court martial. He was convicted of being in the zone contrary to the British regulations. Other Separatists are awaiting trial.

Sofia, Nov. 4th.—Colonel Krastich, the Jugo-Slav military attache here, was savagely attacked on Friday night by three armed men in his office. The Colonel was badly injured about the head. The trio gained admittance on a pretext of handing over an important document.
