Thirty-Fifth Legislature of the Virgin Islands

September 12, 2023

An Act granting a zoning use variance for Parcel No. Remainder 30C Estate Elizabeth, No. 8i, Great Northside Quarter, St. Thomas, from the R-2 (Residential-Low Density One and Two Family) zoning designation to allow for a scenic lookout with a restaurant/bar and gift shop

PROPOSED BY: Senator Novelle E. Francis, Jr., by Request of the Governor

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Virgin Islands:

SECTION 1. Pursuant to title 29, Virgin Islands Code, chapter 3, section 238a, a zoning use variance from the R-2 (Residential-Low Density One and Two Family) zoning designation is granted for Parcel No. Remainder 30C Estate Elizabeth, No. 8i, Great Northside Quarter, St. Thomas, consisting of 1.251 acres as described on Drawing No. D9-81 06-T008, to allow for the development of a scenic lookout with a restaurant/bar and gift shop. All the other requirements of the R-2 (Residential–Low Density-One and Two Family) zoning designation continue to apply to the property.

BILL SUMMARY

This bill grants a zoning use variance for Parcel No. Remainder 30C Estate Elizabeth, No. 8i, Great Northside Quarter, St. Thomas, from the R-2 (Residential-Low Density One and Two Family) zoning designation to allow for a scenic lookout with a restaurant/bar and gift shop.
