Resolution—That the Governor is hereby authorized to rent or lease, for such amounts as in his judgment shall seem proper, any public land or buildings not necessary for public use etc. Introduced by 2nd Appointed Member (Noll).
This matter was rejected on the 18th day of August, 1919.
10. Colonial Council Bill No. 10.
Additional Money Bill to the Budget. Subsidy in aid to Century Brass Band of Frederiksted and Native Brass Band of Christiansted. Introduced by 1st Member for Christiansted Town (Abramson).
Adopted August 18, 1919.
Approved by the Governor August 27, 1919.
11. Colonial Council Bill No. 11.
Resolution—Authorizing the Governor to borrow the sum of Frs. 25,000 from the Reserve Fund to be applied in accordance with the terms of Colonial Council Bill No 12, Session 19 19-20
Adopted October 20, 1919.
Approved by the Governor October 27, 1919.
12. Colonial Council Bill No 12.
Additional Money Bill to the Budget for the Municipality of St. Croix for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1920. For the Purchase of the building known as the Frederiksted High School, No. 30, 30a, 30c, and 31 Strand Street Frederiksted. Frs. 25,000. Introduced by 1st Appointed Member (Henderson).
Adopted October 27, 1919.
Approved by the Governor October 27, 1920.
13. Colonial Council Bill No 13.
Draft of Ordinance, introduced by 2nd Appointed Member (Noll) to provide for a re-organization, regulation, and government of the Municipal Police Force of St. Croix.
Adopted November 17, 1919.
Approved by the Governor December 6, 1919.
14. Colonial Council Bill No. 14.
Draft of Ordinance, introduced by 5th Appointed Member (Lunney), to regulate and control the prices of foodstuffs in the Municipality of St. Croix, and for other purposes.
Adopted October 20, 1919.
Approved by the Governor October 27, 1919.
15. Colonial Council Bill No. 15.
Provisional Ordinance—That such further amounts, in local currency as will equal the difference between the normal rate of exchange \$1.04

- and the rate of exchange existing, and increasing the Budget in the amount necessary to provide for the aforesaid payments.
Adopted October 20, 1919.
Approved by the Governor October 27, 1919.
16. Colonial Council Bill No. 16.
Resolution—Authorizing the Chairman of the Colonial Council to appoint a standing committee of nine members to receive and consider advance copies of a Code of Laws to succeed the present existing laws.
Adopted October 20, 1919.
Approved by the Governor October 27, 1919.
17. Colonial Council Bill No. 17.
Additional Money Bill to the Budget for the Municipality of St. Croix for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1920, introduced by 2nd Appointed Member [Noll]—Increases in salaries to effect a re-organization of the Municipal Police Force.
Adopted December 15, 1919.
Approved by the Governor December 29, 1919.
18. Colonial Council Bill No. 18.
Additional Money Bill to the Budget for the Municipality of St. Croix for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1920, granting Frs. 10,000.00 to be expended during the period from January 1, 1920 to June 30, 1920 inclusive, for the establishing and maintaining of Government Attorney's Office.
Adopted December 15, 1919.
Approved by the Governor December 29, 1919.
19. Colonial Council Bill No. 19.
Resolution—That the unexpended portion of the pension granted former Teacher Alexander Joseph, Sub. Item XIII No 6 on the Budget for the Municipality of St. Croix, 1919-20, be paid to his widow Mrs. Margaret Alicia Joseph. Introduced by 2nd Member for Christiansted Town (Canegata).
Adopted December 15, 1919.
Approved by the Governor December 29, 1919.
20. Colonial Council Bill No 20.
Draft of Ordinance introduced by 2nd Member for Christiansted Town (Canegata), providing for a Hearse for the poor of Christiansted.
Adopted December 15, 1919.
Approved by the Governor April 7, 1920.
21. Colonial Council Bill No. 21.
Additional Money Bill to the Budget for the Municipality of St. Croix for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1920, introduced by 2nd Member for Christiansted Town [Canegata] for the purchase of 1 hearse not to exceed Francs 500.00
Adopted December 15, 1919.
Approved by the Governor April 7, 1920.

22. Colonial Council Bill No. 22.
Resolution. -- Assigning additional land to the Leper Asylum. Introduced by 3rd Member for Christiansted Country District Robt. W. Skeoch).
Adopted December 15, 1919.
Approved by the Governor December 29, 1919.
23. Colonial Council Bill No. 23.
Resolution.—Authorizing the Governor to increase amounts budgetted for the current fiscal year by a percentage not to exceed that by which the rate of exchange for the current fiscal year exceed the normal rate Introduced by Government.
Adopted March 1, 1920.
Approved by the Governor March 11, 1920.
