2nd. Member for Christiansted Town (Canegata): Any other amendment could be brought in as a supplementary measure.

4th. Member for Frederiksted Country District (Andersen) remarked: Mr. Vice Chairman. I intend to give the matter a very careful study and if we close 2nd. discussion only Government can bring in amendment.

Government Secretary [Zane] remarked: Mr. Vice-Chairman. The only point that I can see that will require immediate expedition is the salary of the Chairman of the Road Commission. Apart from that Government has no objection in letting the ordinance go over until the next meeting.

2nd Member for Christiansted Town [Canegata]: In view of the remarks made by the Government Secretary and the Despatching Secretary I move that 2nd discussion come on today.

Government Secretary [Zane] remarked: Mr. Vice-Chairman. I was going on the assumption that this ordinance would eventually become law, but if I am wrong in that assumption I reiterate that the Despatching Secretary would not be within his right to pay more money than that provided by law. I agree with the Honorable 2nd Member for Christiansted Town that it is necessary to expedite the matter today.

4th Member for Frederiksted Country District [Andersen] remarked: Mr. Vice-Chairman. It is expected that an extraordinary meeting of the Council will be called in the very near future, so I see no harm in letting 2nd discussion remain open.

2nd Member for Christiansted Town

[Canegata] proposed that Sections 8, 11 and 12 as amended be adopted.

1st Member for Frederiksted Town [Jackson] remarked: Mr. Vice-Chairman. I would second the Honorable Member's proposal if he would produce authority for closing one discussion on one section and keeping the others open.

2nd Member for Christiansted Town [Canegata] remarked: Mr. Vice-Chairman. I am thoroughly within my right, and any member of the Colonial Council has the right to ask that an amendment be furthered. The member cannot stop me. It takes the vote of the Council only to do that.

1st Member for Frederiksted Town (Jackson) remarked: Mr. Vice-Chairman. I don't think it is in keeping with the rules of business. When a discussion is closed it is closed as to the whole draft.

2nd Member for Christiansted Town (Canegata) Mr. Vice-Chairman. The Honorable Member forgets that the draft is already passed and this is only an amendment to it.

1st Member for Frederiksted Town (Jackson) remarked: Mr. Vice-Chairman. That's quite right, but it seems that the question raised is as if the draft had been introduced anew. The Honorable 4th Member for Frederiksted Country District (Andersen) has brought in amendment to another section of the draft. That opens discussion on the main draft. If the Honorable Member can show me authority I would be willing to vote.

2nd Member for Christiansted Town (Canegata) Mr. Vice-Chairman: If that is the case I object to the amendment of the Honorable 4th Member for Frederiksted Country District coming up today. The (Vice-Chairman). Is the Honor-

able 4th Member for Frederiksted Country District willing to withdraw his amendment.

4th Member for Frederiksted Country District: I will not, but I can leave the meeting and then you will not have a quorum, but I do not care to play politics of such a mean kind.

1st. Member for Frederiksted Town [Jackson] remarked: Mr. Vice-Chairman. When the Honorable 2nd Member for Christiansted Town asked to close discussion on one paragraph of the Ordinance and let the others remain open on 2nd. discussion I don't think that's in order.

4th Member for Frederiksted Country District (Andersen) remarked: Mr. Vice-Chairman. If there is no money to pay the Chairman of the Road Commission they can loan the amount. Borrow it from me.

2nd Member for Frederiksted Town (Canegata). Mr. Vice-Chairman. Would it make any difference if the Honorable 4th Member for Frederiksted Country District withdraw his amendment and introduce it at the next meeting?

The Vice Chairman remarked: Any one familiar with the situation can agree with the amendment. If the Honorable Government Secretary knew our conditions better he might be also willing to agree to the amendment.

1st Member for Frederiksted Town (Jackson) remarked: Mr. Vice-Chairman. If 2nd discussion is closed today that wouldn't give the Despatching Secretary authority to give a check to the Chairman of the Road Commission for more money than the law allows.

Government Secretary (Zane) remarked: Mr. Vice-Chairman. I do not wish the Honorable 4th Member for Frederiksted Country District to think that I in any way suspect the amendment brought in by him. I did consider that the Government should have a chance to determine for itself the meaning of the amendment. I now realize that the remark I made was unnecessary. If the Honorable 4th Member for Frederiksted Country District considers that I said anything I should not have said I wish to apologise.

4th Member for Frederiksted Country District (Andersen) remarked: Mr. Vice-Chairman. The Government Secretary plays very fairly. There is no harm in letting the matter go over until the next meeting. I feel certain that an extraordinary meeting will be called.

The Vice-Chairman remarked: The bill goes over to the next meeting on 2nd discussion.

There being no further business before the House the Vice-Chairman declared the meeting closed at 6.30 p. m.
