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lost the fight at this point. It was plain to some that he lost heart, lacking the punch to hit the champion out, when he was groggy. In the third round Carpentier continued his running fight. He tried several fancy dancing steps and got away when Dempsey backed him to the ropes. The third time Dempsey showed his speed and cracked a terrible right as he tried to get away. Carpentier was missing with his right. He was taking a desperate chance to win with one shot. Dempsey with even so slight a motion of his hand would turn to the right and left and the blows of the Frenchman slid off the champion wet head. In the fourth round Jack Kearns yelled from Dempsey's corner go after him now boy, you have got him." Dempsey wide open sneering at the Frenchman did go at him and knocked him out. Dempsey was given a tremendous ovation. The hostility of the public on account of his war record was expected to bring him perhaps the jeers and boos that he got when he beat Brennan last winter. Carpentier also got a great reception. He was a good loser. He smiled at the crowd and walked rather dejectedly from the ring.
