PROCEEDINGS OF THE COLONIAL COUNCIL FOR ST. CROIX.

Continued from yesterday's Avis

2nd Member Frederiksted Country District (M. M. Skeoch) remarked: Mr. Chairman. In regard to Road Inspection I agree with Member Andersen, but while I do not wish to criticise the present Road Officer, I feel sorry for the Chairman of the Road Commission. I know that if I had to deal with the roads I would do so harshly. The law gives the Chairman the power to fine, but he has never done so. When you take into consideration the duties incumbent upon

the Chairman I think he is very meanly remunerated.

Whenever my road is in bad condition I always try to put it in order, but there are some who do not try to put their road in order when it is in bad condition.

1st Member for Frederiksted Country District (Andersen) remarked: Mr. Chairman. When we inspected the roads sometime ago we recommended that a tree on Strawberry Hill dangerous to traffic that should be removed; it is still there and not yet taken out; that shows that we need more road inspection.

Public Works Officer [Lieut. Pettigrew] remarked: Mr. Chairman. Under this budget the Chairman of the Road Commission has Frcs. 6000 per year and in addition is allowed traveling expenses of Frcs. 1000 per year.
