Thirty-Sixth Legislature of the Virgin Islands

An act amending title 3 Virgin Islands Code, chapter 27, section 711 and chapter 28a, section 760, by requiring the Government Employees Retirement System to discontinue making disability retirement annuity payments to a member who resumes any employment

PROPOSED BY: Senator Alma Francis Heyliger

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Virgin Islands:

SECTION 1. Title 3 Virgin Islands Code is amended as follows:

(a) chapter 27, section 711 is amended by striking all the language in subsection (b) and inserting the following new language:

“The System shall discontinue making duty disability retirement annuity payments or nonduty disability retirement annuity payments to a member who resumes any employment.”

(b) chapter 28a, section 760 is amended by striking all the language in subsection (b) and inserting the following new language:

“The System shall discontinue making duty disability retirement annuity payments or nonduty disability retirement annuity payments to a member who resumes any employment.”

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BILL SUMMARY

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This bill amends title 3 Virgin Islands Code, chapter 27, section 711 and chapter 28a, section 760, by requiring the Government Employees Retirement System to discontinue making duty or nonduty disability retirement annuity payments to a member who resumes any employment.
