PROCEEDINGS

OF THE

COLONIAL COUNCIL

FOR ST. CROIX.

(Concluded from yesterday's Avis.)

7. Letter from Despatching Secretary to Chairman of the Colonial Council of May 15, 1922, reading:

15 May, 1922.

From: Despatching Secretary.

To : Chairman of Colonial Council, St. Croix

Subject: Appointment of Jury Commissioner.

Reference: Section 4, Title V., Chapter 12, of the Code of Laws for St. Croix.

1. The reference requires the Colonial Council annually to appoint a Jury Commissioner. The present appointee of Council, Mr. K. Henderson of Frederiksted, is holding over under an appointment dated October 1920.

2. It is requested that Council be

asked to appoint some one for this office.

18. Letter from Despatching Secretary to the Chairman of Colonial Council of May 16, 1922, reading:

16 May, 1922.

From: Despatching Secretary,

To : Chairman, Colonial Council, Municipality of St. Croix, V.I.

Subject: Election of member of Library Commission by Colonial Council.

Reference: Ordinance of 22 May 1920.

1. It is hereby brought to your notice, that in accordance with paragraph 2 of the above reference, Mr. F. Coulter of Frederiksted was elected by the Colonial Council at its meeting of 21 June, 1920, as member of the Library Commission, for a period of two years. His term of office therefore expires in June 1922.

2. It is requested that Council elect a member to take office at the expiration of the term of the present incumbent.

The Acting Chairman remarked: I have received no excuse from the absent member.

The Acting Chairman then brought up item 1 of the Order of the Day and asked Members to prepare their voting tickets for the election of a Chairman.

Item 1.

Election of Council's Officials.

Election of a Chairman:

17 voting tickets were handed in.

Elected was 2nd Member for Frederiksted Town (Merwin) with 15 votes,

2nd Member for Christiansted Town (Canegata) and 4th Member for Christiansted Country District (Ramsay) received 1 vote respectively.

The Chairman (Merwin) took the Chair and said,---I thank you Gentlemen for the confidence expressed and for re-electing me as Chairman. I hope I will be able, during the year, to satisfy you.

Election of a Vice-Chairman:

16 voting tickets were handed in.

1st Member for Frederiksted Town (Coulter) received 7 votes, 2nd Member for Christiansted Town (Canegata) 4 votes, 4th Appointed Member (Blackwood) and 1st Member for Frederiksted Country District (Andersen) 2 votes respectively and 1st Member for Christiansted Country District (Jessen) received 1 vote.

As none had absolute majority a new free voting had to take place.

16 voting tickets were handed in, one was blank.

Elected was 1st Member for Frederiksted Town (Coulter) with 9 votes.

2nd Member for Christiansted Town (Canegata) received 6 votes.

Election of a Secretary.

16 voting tickets were handed in.

Elected was 2nd Member for Christiansted Town (Canegata) with 13 votes.

1st Member for Christiansted Town

(Abramson), 3rd Appointed Member (Armstrong) and 3rd Member for Christiansted Country District (Robt. W. Skeoch) received one vote respectively.

Election of an Assistant Secretary.

16 voting tickets were handed in.

Elected was 3rd Member for Christiansted Country District (Robt. W. Skeoch) with 12 votes.

3rd Member for Christiansted Town (Alexander) received 2 votes, 1st Member for Frederiksted Country District (Andersen) and 1st Member for Christiansted Town Abramson received 1 vote respectively.

Item 2.

Election of Members of the Municipal Committee and Substitutes.

The voting took place in this manner, 2 names were written on the voting ticket, the first name signified the Member for the Committee and the second name the Substitute.

For an Appointed Member.

16 voting tickets were handed in.

Elected as Member was 4th Appointed Member (Blackwood).

As Substitute 2nd Appointed Member (Noll) received 7 votes, 1st Appointed Member (Henderson) received 4 votes, 5th Appointed Member (McIntosh) received 3 votes and 3rd Appointed Member (Armstrong) 2 votes.

As none of the Substitutes had absolute majority a new voting had to take place for a Substitute.

16 voting tickets were handed in.

1st Appointed Member (Henderson) received 7 votes, 2nd Appointed Member (Noll) 5 votes, 3rd Appointed Member (Armstrong) and 5th Appointed Member (McIntosh) received 2 votes respectively.

As none had absolute majority a new voting had to take place between 1st Appointed Member (Henderson) and 2nd Appointed Member (Noll).

16 voting tickets were handed in.

Elected was 1st Appointed Member (Henderson) with 10 votes.

2nd Appointed Member (Noll) received 6 votes.

For Christiansted Town:

16 voting tickets were handed in.

Elected as Member was 2nd Member for Christiansted Town (Canegata) with 15 votes.

As Substitute 1st Member for said Town (Abramson) with 11 votes.

3rd Member for Christiansted Town (Alexander) received one vote as Member and 5 votes as Substitute.
