PROCEEDINGS OF THE COLONIAL COUNCIL FOR ST. CROIX.

Continued from yesterday's Avis.

4th Member for Frederiksted Country District (Fleming) brought in an amendment to the Committee Report as follows:

AMENDMENT TO COMMITTEE REPORT

on Ordinance providing for the repairing and rolling of the Center Line Road.

9th line: put a period after the word estate, and strike out the words, irrespective of the nature of cultivation.

The Chairman put the amendment to the vote.

2nd Member for Christiansted Town (Canegata): Mr. Chairman. I intend bringing in an amendment to this paragraph. My reason is this—I think the Code already provides what procedure shall be adopted if the tax is not paid, so I don't think it necessary to let this remain in the ordinance.

2nd Member for Frederiksted Country District (Curry): What part of the Code?

2nd Member for Christiansted Town (Canegata): I don't remember just now.

2nd Member for Christiansted Town (Canegata): You can make levy on any person in this municipality for non-payment of taxes, can you not?

2nd Member for Frederiksted Country District (Curry): According to the particular terms of that act. Each of the acts has its special provision as far as I remember.

1st Member for Frederiksted Country District (Andersen) remarked: Mr. Chairman. In my opinion these three lines does not do very much harm. It says "may be" instead of "shall be".

2nd Member for Christiansted Town (Canegata): I will not give my vote for any such law. That's the reason why I will vote against it.

2nd Member for Frederiksted Country District (Curry): In the Code it is stated that "may" shall mean "shall" and "shall" shall mean "may".
