THIS is a reminder to all roadholders that the annual inspection of the Public roads will take place in the month of January 1923.

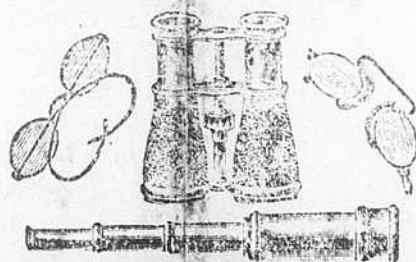
