Red Cross Annual Roll Call

Jan. 23--Feb. 6, 1922.

The annual Roll Call of the local Red Cross Chapter will begin Monday January 23rd, and extend through February 6th. These two weeks are set aside so that former members may renew their membership and new members may join. Last year the Santa Cruz Chapter tallied over two thousand members and this year's enrollment should equal, if not exceed that number.

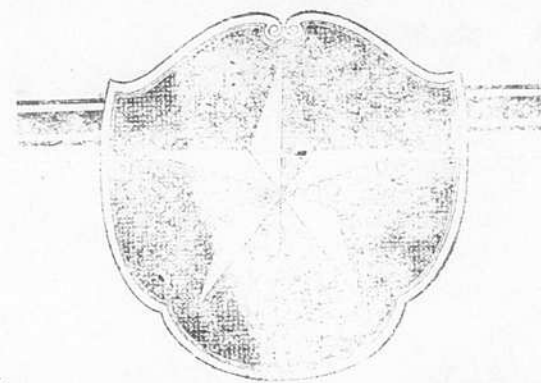
The two towns of Frederiksted and Christiansted have been districted and a house to house canvass will be made to facilitate the enrollment. The dues for membership have not changed, but the amount to be retained for chapter work has been increased. The following indicates the kinds of membership and their division.

Life and Patron Membership dues go to the National Endowment Fund. The amount retained by the local chapter is divided between the Chapter headquarters at Frederiksted and the Branch at Christiansted according to the memberships in each district.

During the past year Home Service Committees have been formed in Frederiksted and Christiansted. These committees have rendered many kinds of service to families in need of advice and help. Relatives, who have not been heard from after leaving the Islands for the States or other parts, have been traced, support has been secured for children and aged parents; practically every kind of family problem has been presented for help and adjustment.

In Christiansted a Sewing Committee has met weekly. After making supplies for the local hospital, attention was turned to the equipment of a Loan Closet, which is furnished with bed linen and bed-gowns to be lent out to sick people who are not hospital cases, but are confined to bed and in need of comfortable bed coverings. The bedding is returned after the recovery of the pa-



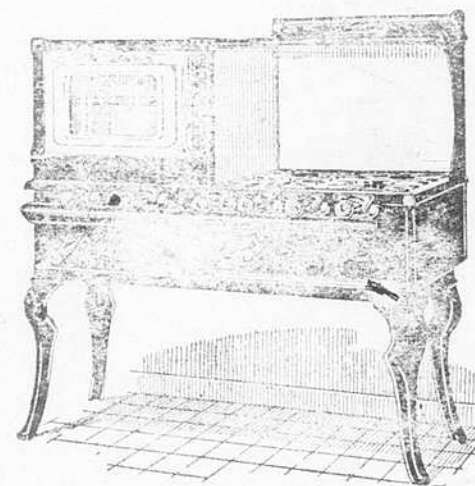
