The Tutu Environmental Investigation Committee (TEIC) is implementing a Remedial Investigation (RI) that includes an evaluation of the groundwater quality in the Tutu area. This RI is being conducted according to a work plan approved by the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (USEPA) and is being coordinated with the U.S. Virgin Islands Department of Planning and Natural Resources (DPNR).

On behalf of the TEIC, Geraghty & Miller, Inc. is coordinating the sampling activities. 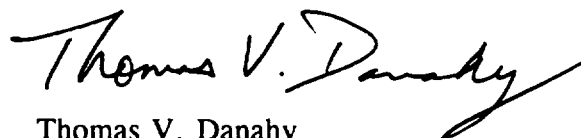
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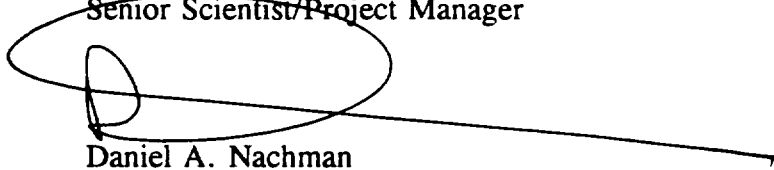
