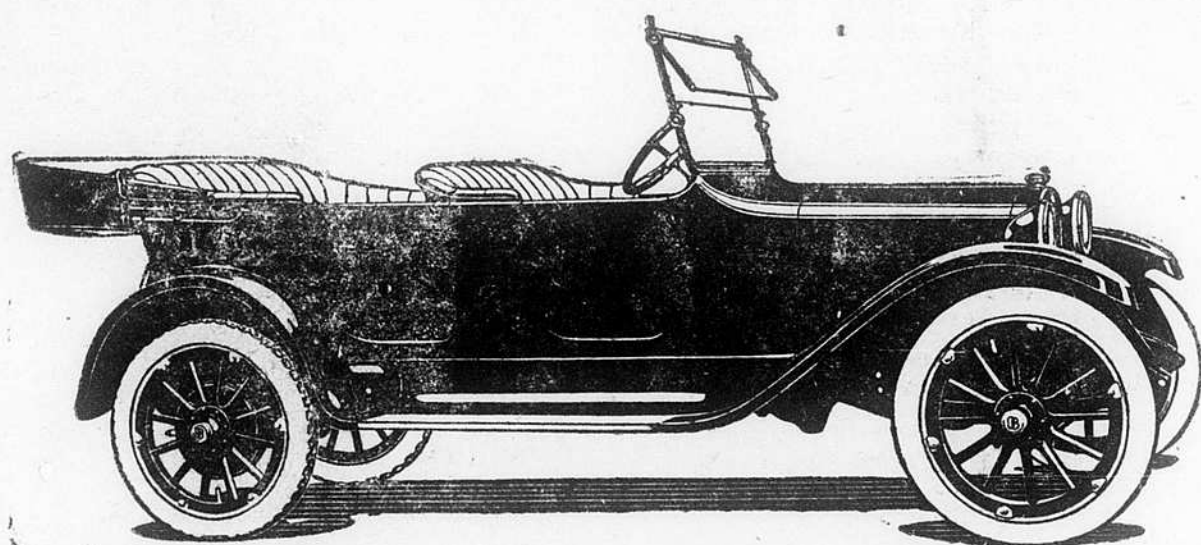

PROCEEDINGS OF THE COLONIAL COUNCIL FOR ST. CROIX.

(Continued from yesterday's Avis.)

For Christiansted Country District:
16 voting tickets were handed in, two were blank.
Elected as Member was 3rd Member

for Christiansted Country District (Robt. W. Skeoch) with 12 votes.

As Substitute was elected 1st Member for said District (Jessen) with 11 votes.
2nd Member for Christiansted Country District (Nelthropp) received 2 votes as Member and 3 as Substitute.

For Frederiksted Town:

15 voting tickets were handed in, two were blank.

Elected as Member was 2nd Member for Frederiksted Town (Merwin) with 13 votes.

As Substitute was elected 1st Member for said Town (Coulter) with 13 votes.

For Frederiksted Country District:

16 voting tickets were handed in, one was blank.

Elected as Member was 1st Member for Frederiksted Country District (Andersen) with 9 votes.

As Substitute was elected 3rd Member for said District (M. M. Skeoch) with 9 votes.

4th Member for Frederiksted Country District (Fleming) received 7 votes as Member and 5 votes as Substitute.

Item 3.

Election of a Chaplain.

15 voting tickets were handed in, two were blank.

Rev. Allen received 6 votes, Rev. Pigott 4 votes, Rev. Agaard 2 votes and Father Claire 1 vote.

As none had absolute majority a new voting had to take place.

17 voting tickets were handed in.

Rev. Allen received 5 votes, Rev. Bough and Rev. Pigott received 4 votes respectively, Father Claire received 2 votes and Rev. Agaard 1 vote.

As none had absolute majority a new voting had to take place between Rev. Allen and Rev. Pigott.

16 voting tickets were handed in, two were blank.

Reverend Allen was elected with 9 votes.

Rev. Pigott received 4 votes and Rev. Bough received 1 vote.

Item 4.

Election of Members of the Public Cemeteries' Commission.

4th Appointed Member (Blackwood) took the word and said,—I am given to understand that nothing has been done to the Cemetery in Frederiksted, whether it is the fault of the Commission I do not know, however whenever a man is elected to serve on a commission he should attend to the business allotted to him.

1st Member for Frederiksted Country District (Andersen) left the meeting.

16 voting tickets were handed in for the election of the Cemeteries' Commission.

3rd Member for Christiansted Town (Alexander) received 6 votes.

For Frederiksted:

Robt. L. Merwin with 12 votes.

1st Member for Frederiksted Town (Coulter) received 4 votes.

Item 5.

Election according to Ordinance of 17th January, 1908, Paragraph 6, of one member to enter the Board of Management of the Asylum for Lepers etc.

14 voting tickets were handed in.
