PROCEEDINGS OF THE COLONIAL COUNCIL FOR ST. CROIX.

AT one o'clock p. m., Monday, March 21, 1921, the Colonial Council of St. Croix held an extraordinary meeting in the Colonial Council Hall at Christiansted.

The following members were present: The Chairman (Robt. L. Merwin), F. Coulter, A. J. Blackwood, G. B. Fleming, G. Nordby, D. S. Armstrong, F. Andersen, A. E. Stakemann, F. Lunney, Robt. W. Skeoch, M. M. Skeoch, K. Henderson and D. O. Canegata.

Absent were 2nd Member for Christiansted Country District (McKay), 4th Member for said District (Ramsy) and 3rd Member for Christiansted Town (Pentheny).

2nd Appointed Member (Noll) and 1st Member for Christiansted Town (Abramson) sent in excuse of their inability to attend the meeting.

Commander Gaffney, Financial Aid to the Governor and Despatching Secretary Fox attended the meeting.

After prayers had been said the Chairman remarked: Honorable Members the minutes for the last meeting have been published as customary in the "St. Croix Avis" if there are no objections I will

consider the minutes as published tacitly adopted.

There being no objections the Chairman declared the minutes as published tacitly adopted.

The Chairman remarked: I have received excuse from 2nd Appointed Member (Noll) of his inability to attend the meeting owing to his absence from the island.

1st. Appointed Member (Henderson) then entered the meeting.

The Chairman then read the following communications to the Council received since the last meeting:

1. Letter from 1st member for Frederiksted Country District (Andersen) of March 11, 1921, forwarding draft of an ordinance with the request that same be placed before extraordinary meeting of the Council at the earliest possible date.

2. Letter from 1st. Member for Frederiksted Town (Coulter), under date of March 15, a. c., forwarding resolution in duplicate with the request that same be placed on the order of the day for the extraordinary meeting of the Council to be held Monday, 21st. inst.

3. Letter from Government under date of March 16, a. c., transmitting draft of an ordinance and copy of an executive order from the President of the United States.

The Chairman read the letter referred to above and said, -This letter was received by on Saturday afternoon and too late to be placed on the order of the day for this

meeting, however I will have it printed and circulated among members and it will come up at the next meeting.

The Secretary (Canegata) then read the ordinance to the Council, and the Chairman remarked: As I stated previously this was received only Saturday afternoon. I take this opportunity to acquaint the Council that it will be printed on Monday and forwarded to member.

The Chairman then read excuse from 1st Member for Christiansted Town (Abramson) of his inability to attend the meeting.

The Chairman then brought up item 1 of the order of the day.

Item 1.

Colonial Council Bill No. 55
2nd Council, 2nd Session 1920-21.
Introduction of and 1st Discussion on Colonial Council Bill No. 55, Draft of an Ordinance providing for the sum of Frcs. 250,000 to rebuild with concrete the center line road between Frederiksted and Christiansted in accordance with plan approved by the Public Works Officer. Introduced by 1st Member for Frederiksted Country District F. Andersen.

The Bill reads as follows:

Colonial Council Bill No. 55.
2nd Council, 2nd Session, 1921.

AN ORDINANCE

Section I. Be it enacted by the Colonial Council for St. Croix: that the sum of Frcs: 250,000 is hereby immediately available for the project to rebuild with concrete the centre line road between Frederiksted and Christiansted, in accordance with the plan approved by the Public Works Office.

Section II. PROVIDED: That the Governor be, and he is hereby, authorized to borrow on the credit of the Municipality of St. Croix from time to time, such sums not to exceed Frcs: 500,000 as, in his judgment may be required to rebuild the aforesaid road, or to reimburse the Municipal Treasury for such expenditure, to prepare and issue for this purpose bonds of the Municipality of St. Croix not to exceed Frcs: 500,000 in such form as he may prescribe, bearing interest payable semi annually at a rate not to exceed 5 per centum per annum; and both interest and principal shall be exempt from local taxation, provided that they shall be disposed of at not less than par under such regulations as the Governor may prescribe, at the most
