Y., all its property, including among other things all trademarks and registrations thereof, instrument dated August 23, 1923 and recorded in the United States Patent Office, on October 29, 1923; and that the said assignments with respect to the above mentioned trademark No. 33,389, have this date been recorded in the Office of the Government Secretary of the Virgin Islands of the United States, at St. Thomas, in accordance with the provisions in the regulations governing the registration of patents and trademarks in the Virgin Islands, approved June 30, 1920.
