### NEW SANTURCE CARRETERA TO BE FINISHED THIS YEAR.

Sections Of New Street From San Antonio Bridge to Martin Pena are Already Completed.

With the construction of the new carretera which is to run parallel with the main carretera, properly known as Ponce de Leon avenue, and which is to extend from Miramar to Martin Pena, Santurce will take on a new aspect, and residents may be justified in hoping for better things in the way of traffic safety at least.

The congested condition of the main carretera has been a problem for many years putting the lives of school children, and in fact of the average pedestrian, in jeopardy and making the avoiding of motor collisions almost impossible. It is believed that the new carretera will do much to relieve this situation, and as it is to be a modern city street with sidewalks, and parking, it will add largely to the appearance of that part of the city.

In a report from the office of the Commissioner of the Interior it is stated that "the construction of this carretera was begun the latter part of last September, and the work of construction has been carried on as rapidly as possible in spite of the difficulties which have arisen such as the trouble of obtaining materials and strikes."

This carretera is to branch out from the main carretera near to San Antonio bridge. From there it will cross the trolley line and continue westward to Miramar as far as Congress street. Af-
