PROCEEDINGS OF THE COLONIAL COUNCIL FOR ST. CROIX.

ON Monday, October 17, 1921, at one
o'clock p. m., the Colonial Council of
St. Croix held its Third Ordinary Meet-
ing for the present elective period in the
Colonial Council Hall in Christiansted.

The following Members were pres-
ent: A. J. (Blackwood), D. C. Cane-
gata, Robt. W. Skeoch, W. S. Abram-
son, G. B. Fleming, F. Andersen,
Holger Jessen, John L. Curry, K. Hen-
derson, A. V. Nelthropp, J. Alexander,
A. R. McIntosh and M. M. Skeoch.

2nd Member for Frederiksted Town
(Merwin), 2nd Appointed Member (Noll),
4th Member for Christiansted Country
District (Ramsay) and 1st Member for
Frederiksted Town (Coulter) were ab-
sent.

Government Secretary (Gaffney) and
Despatching Secretary (Rappolee) attend-
ed the meeting.

Owing to the absence of both the Chair-
man and Vice-Chairman from the Island
the 4th Appointed Member (Blackwood)
took the Chair as Senior Chairman.

After prayers had been said the Senior
Chairman (Blackwood) remarked: Hon-
orable Members. The Council has as-
sembled today under very unusual cir-
cumstances. Both Chairman and Vice-
Chairman being absent from the island.
This is the first time during my time in
this Council this has occurred; and that
compells me, as Senior Chairman to
open the meeting. In looking through
the Rules of Business I find that the

rules and regulations prescribe very
little rules for the Senior Chairman to
act. It seems to me that when these
rules were formulated this occurrence
was so unusual that it was not considered
necessary to make provisions for such,
and it was taken for granted that the
Senior Chairman should act. Par. 3 of
the Rules of Business says in part:
"Should the Chairman and Vice-Chair-
man be among the number of retiring
members or be prevented from acting the
election shall take place under the direc-
tion of the Senior Chairman." This, I
suppose, applies to a meeting of this
kind. Under these circumstances, I ask
that members prepare their voting tick-
ets for a Chairman to conduct this meet-
ing. The voting of course is by ballot.

13 voting tickets were handed in for
the election of a Chairman.

Elected was: Third Member for Chris-
tiansted Country District (Robt. W.
Skeoch) with 7 votes.

4th Appointed Member (Blackwood)
received 5 votes, and 2nd Member for
Christiansted Town (Canegata) received
1 vote.

3rd Appointed Member (Armstrong)
entered the meeting.

The Acting Chairman (Robt. W.
Skeoch) took the Chair and remarked:
Honorable Members I have to thank you
for electing me Chairman of this meet-
ing. I should prefer to see the Senior
Chairman in the Chair, but I must do so
as I am told.

The Patent of election of 1st Member
for Christiansted Country District (Hol-
ger Jessen) which had not been produced
at the last meeting was presented, and
having been found in order was, by the
Chairman, ordered to be placed on file.

The Chairman remarked: The min-
utes for the last meeting have been
published in the "St. Croix Avis"
as customary, and unless members
have objections I will consider same
tacitly adopted.

There being no objection the Chairman
declared the minutes as published tacitly
adopted.

The following communications receiv-
ed since the last meeting of the Council
were then read:

1. Letter from Government to Chair-
man of the Colonial Council of Octo-
ber 4, a. c., forwarding draft of Ad-
ditional Money Bill to the Budget for
the Municipality of St. Croix for the
fiscal year ending June 30, 1922,
with the request that same be enter-
ed on the Order of the Day for the
next meeting of the Colonial Council
of St. Croix.

2. Letter to 4th Appointed Member for
Colonial Council reading:
