AN ACT

To authorize the Secretary of the Interior to enter into a long-term lease with the Government of the United States Virgin Islands to provide land on the island of Saint John, Virgin Islands, for the establishment of a school, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

1 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

2 This Act may be cited as the “Virgin Islands Na-
3 tional Park School Lease Act”.

4 **SEC. 2. LONG-TERM LEASE, VIRGIN ISLANDS NATIONAL**
5 **PARK, SAINT JOHN, VIRGIN ISLANDS.**

6 (a) **LEASE AUTHORIZED.**—The Secretary of the Inte-
7 rior may lease to the Government of the United States
8 Virgin Islands a parcel of real property, including any im-
9 provements thereon, located within the boundaries of Vir-
10 gin Islands National Park on the island of Saint John,
11 Virgin Islands, as depicted on the map entitled “Virgin
12 Islands National Park School Exchange”, numbered 161/
13 80,037, and dated September 19, 2007, for the purpose
14 of providing a suitable location for the establishment of
15 a school by the Government of the United States Virgin
16 Islands on the island.

17 (b) **TERM OF LEASE.**—The lease authorized by sub-
18 section (a) may not exceed a term of 99 years.

19 (c) **AVAILABILITY OF MAP.**—The map referred to in
20 subsection (a) shall be on file and available for public in-
21 spection in the appropriate offices of the National Park
22 Service.

23 (d) **ADDITIONAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS.**—The
24 Secretary may require such additional terms and condi-
25 tions in connection with the lease under this section as

1 the Secretary considers appropriate to protect the inter-
2 ests of the United States.
