About \$1200 worth of musical instruments, enough to equip three complete school orchestras, has been sent down as a gift to the children of these islands from their little friends in the North. They will be used to develop an orchestra in each of the three public High Schools in St. Thomas and St. Croix.

"This gift happens to coincide remarkably well with the increased attention which we are giving in the public schools to musical instruction," said Mr. D. R. Nase, Director of Education. "The instruments will be used under the direction of Bandmaster Adams and the musical instructors, and will, I am sure, be of great assistance in stimulating the children in their study of music."
