IT is hereby made known that the Horse, Carriage and Boat Tax for the first half year 1924 will be received by the Director of Police in Christiansted and Frederiksted from the 20th January 1924 to the 10th February 1924, both days included, after which the list of arrears will be transmitted to the same authority for further measures.

Each debtor of tax will be subject to a fine of Fres. 1.00 if the tax be under Fres. 25.00 and Fres. 2.00 if the tax be Fres. 25.00 or above, besides the ordinary levy expenses.

The taxlists will be distributed by the Police and are to be filled out in conformity with the ordinance of February 22, 1853 and returned to the respective Police Offices within 48 hours in the towns and 4 days in the country.

IT is hereby made known, that the Tax on Auto Vehicles and Auto Truck Trailers according to Section 31 of the Ordinance concerning Public Roads in St. Croix approved July 14, 1923, will be payable, for the first Half Year of 1924 at the Police Offices in Christiansted and Frederiksted from January 20, 1924 to February 10, 1924, both days included.

Parties remaining in arrears for this tax after February 10, 1924, will be subject to the same penalties as in the case of the Horse, Carriage and Boat Tax.

Tax-lists will be distributed by the Police Department and are required to be correctly filled out and returned to the respective Police Offices two days after receipt in the towns and 4 days after receipt in the country.
