Summer Dress

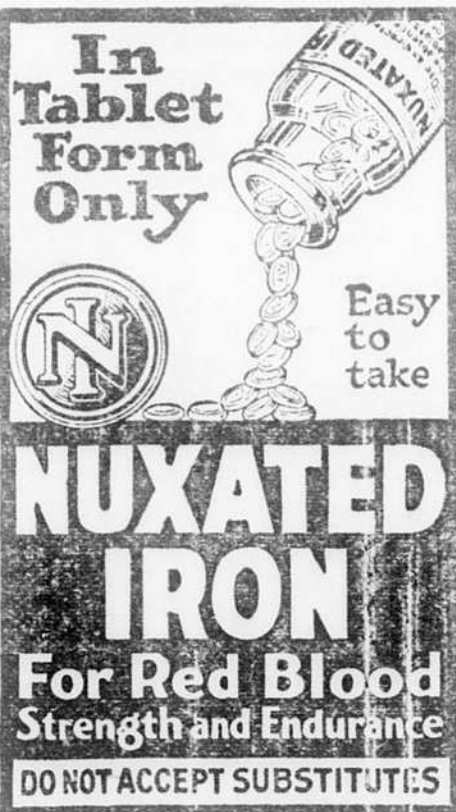
