PROCEEDINGS OF THE COLONIAL COUNCIL FOR ST. CROIX.

(Continued from yesterday's Avis.)

Item 5.

Colonial Council Bill No. 25.

Fourth Council, First Session.

Introduction of and 1st discussion on Resolution introduced by 1st Member for Frederiksted Town (Jackson) providing for the appointment of a select committee to inquire into the activities of the Department of Education.

The Bill reads as follows:

Colonial Council Bill No. 25.

Fourth Council, First Session, 1923-1924.

RESOLUTION

Providing for an Investigation in the Activities of the Department of Education

Be it resolved by the Colonial Council in session assembled:

That a select Committee of (5) five members from the Council be appointed by the Colonial Council to inquire into the activities of the Department of Education, and for such purposes it shall have power to send for persons and papers and administer oaths, and shall report within (3) three weeks from the date of the passage of this resolution.

It was put to the vote and carried that the Resolution be furthered.

1st Member for Frederiksted Town [Jackson]: Mr. Chairman. I beg permission to withdraw this resolution for the purpose of including other departments

The Resolution was accordingly withdrawn.

The Chairman gave a recess of 10 minutes.

At the resumption the Chairman asked members to prepare their voting tickets for a committee of 5 members to receive and report on Bill No. 8.

13 voting tickets were handed in, one was blank.

Elected were: 2nd Member for Frederiksted Country District [Curry] with 11 votes, 4th Member for Frederiksted Country District [Andersen] with 10 votes, 1st Member for Frederiksted Town [Jackson] and 2nd Member for said Town [Merwin] with 9 votes respectively and 2nd Member for Christiansted Town [Canegata] with 7 votes.

1st Appointed Member [Coulter] received 5 votes, 2nd Appointed Member [Noll] and 3rd Member for Christiansted Town [Alexander] 4 votes respectively, 4th Appointed Member [Blackwood] and 2nd Member for Christiansted Country District [Berg] 2 votes respectively and 3rd Appointed Member [Armstrong] 1 vote.

12 voting tickets were handed in for election of a committee of 5 members to receive and report on Colonial Council Bill No. 13, one was blank.

Elected were: 2nd Member for Frederiksted Town [Merwin] with 9 votes, 4th Appointed Member [Blackwood] and 2nd Member for Frederiksted Country District [Curry] with 7 votes respectively, 2nd Member for Christiansted Town [Canegata] with 6 votes.

4th Member for Frederiksted Country District [Andersen], 3rd Appointed Member [Armstrong] and 3rd Member for Christiansted Town [Alexander] received 5 votes respectively, 1st Member for Frederiksted Town [Jackson], 3 votes, 1st Appointed Member [Coulter], 2nd Member for Christiansted Country District [Berg] and 3rd Member for said District [Robt. W. Skeoch] 2 votes re-

spectively and 2nd Appointed Member (Noll) and 1st Member for Christiansted Town [Abramson] one vote respectively.

As none of the others had a simple majority vote a new voting for another member took place.

13 voting tickets were handed in.

4th Member for Frederiksted Country District [Andersen] received 6 votes and 3rd Member for Christiansted Town [Alexander] received 6 votes. 3rd Appointed Member [Armstrong] received 1 vote.

4th Member for Frederiksted Country District [Andersen] and 3rd Member for Christiansted Town [Alexander] having secured an equal number of votes the former was, according to Par. 12 of the Rules of Business, declared elected.

Item 6.

Colonial Council Bill No. 26.

Fourth Council, First Session.

Introduction of and discussion on Resolution introduced by 2nd Member for Christiansted Country District (Berg) providing for the appointment of a select committee to take a plebiscite of all citizens of the Virgin Islands.

The bill reads as follows:

Colonial Council Bill No. 26

Fourth Council, First Session, 1923-1924.

RESOLUTION.

Whereas a resolution adopted by the Colonial Council of Saint Croix, Saint Thomas and Saint John, at a joint session held April 2, 1924, expressed the opinion that the present form of government should continue until a change is requested which emanates from the people of the Virgin Islands, and whereas it is the consensus of opinion that the people of the Virgin Islands are desirous of having a permanent American form of civil government, — Now, therefore, it is resolved that the Colonial Council of Saint Croix appoint a select committee to forthwith take a plebiscite of all citizens of the Virgin Islands to ascertain their wishes in this respect; and it is further resolved that said committee shall draw up the regulations for the conducting of such plebiscite, the result of which shall be made public within twenty four hours after it shall have been taken.
