Thirty-Fifth Legislature of the Virgin Islands

An Act amending the Rules of the 35th Legislature of the Virgin Islands, Rule 205 (a), by removing the provision that a minority caucus must consist of not less than five Senators

PROPOSED BY: Senator Alma Francis Heyliger

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Virgin Islands:

SECTION 1. Resolution 1901 (Bill No. 35-0002), adopting the Rules of the 35th Legislature of the Virgin Islands, is amended in appendix A, titled Rules of the 35th Legislature of the Virgin Islands, Rule 205 (a), by striking all the language therein and inserting new language to read as follows: “The minority senators may form a minority caucus and elect one member to serve as Minority Leader and shall notify the President in writing.”
