U. S. NAVY "FROGMEN" DEMONSTRATE NEW HIGH SPEED CAST & RECOVERY SYSTEM

The U. S. Navy's Underwater Demolition Swimmers, better known as "Frogmen" demonstrate some of their new tactics and equipment at their winter training headquarters, St. Thomas, Virgin Islands.

Highlight of the demonstration is a spectacular showing of the new high speed cast and recovery system which employs gas turbine boats and rubber cord to snatch men out of the water.

Sequences show:

- (a) Navy "Frogmen" enter water at St. Thomas, V.I.
- (b) Adjusting gear.
- (c) Jumping into water from craft.
- (d) Falling from craft into rubber boat and leaving boat on signal.
- (e) Frogmen being snatched from the sea by rubber cord.

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
