(Alexander) remarked: Mr. Chairman. I concur with the last speaker.

2nd Appointed Member (Noll): All you have to do is, add another chapter to the Code.

1st Member for Frederiksted Town (Coulter) remarked: Mr. Chairman. It is immaterial to me to what course this matter takes whether the Committee meets and revise the regulations or whether they are incorporated in the Code. There is great need for the control of the traffic of motor vehicles on this island. As Director of Police I have that experience, and I recommend that a committee be appointed.

No one requesting the word further, the Secretary (Canegata) read the Resolution and the Acting Chairman put same to the vote.

It was unanimously adopted.

The Acting Chairman then gave a recess of 10 minutes.

After the recess the Council reassembled the Vice Chairman took the Chair and asked members to prepare their voting tickets for a committee of 5 members to receive and revise the Police Regulations.

9 voting tickets were handed in.

Elected were: 1st Member for Frederiksted Town (Coulter), 2nd Appointed Member (Noll) with 9 votes respectively, 3rd Appointed Member (Armstrong) with 8 votes, and 1st Member for Frederiksted Country District (Anderson) and 3rd Member for Christiansted Town (Alexander) with 7 votes respectively.

2nd Member for Christiansted Town (Canegata) with 3 votes, and 3rd Member for Frederiksted Country District (M. M. Skeoch) and 4th Member for said District (Fleming) with 1 vote respectively.

There being no further business be-

the Senior Member of the Council to take the Chair while this matter is being discussed. It is a very simple matter and will only take two minutes. If the Honorable Member sticks to the Rule, I have to ask the Senior Member of the House to take the Chair.

4th Appointed Member (Blackwood) Senior Member of the House took the Chair as Acting Chairman of the Council.

The Acting Chairman read and put to the vote whether the Resolution should be forwarded.

1st Member for Frederiksted Town (Coulter) in introducing the Resolution said, -Honorable Members this Resolution is introduced due to a motion made in the last meeting that all matters pending in the Council after a general election should be reintroduced. This Resolution has the same effect as the one passed by the Council recently, and I believe all members feel the necessity for the revision of the Police regulations. I therefore ask that the same committee be appointed, with the exception of 1st Member for Christiansted Country District (Stakemann) who has retired.

3rd Member for Christiansted Town (Alexander) remarked: Mr. Chairman. In regard to this Resolution introduced by 1st Member for Frederiksted Town (Coulter), I suggest that the automobile law be passed separately instead of being incorporated in the Police Regulations. I think it would be to the benefit of the public to have a special automobile law. In Porto Rico and the United States they have such a law.

1st Member for Frederiksted Town (Coulter) remarked: Mr. Chairman. That's just what this Resolution is meant for. Those who are acquainted with the Police Regulations know that the greater part of it is taken up with regulation concerning dogs, dance, masquerade etc., except automobile; and in 1915 came a special automobile law which embodied the regulations governing the traffic of automobiles. There are many regulations which are very much in need of revision; the motor vehicular regulation is not very comprehensive. I have copies of regulations from Porto Rico and the United States, which I intend to place before the committee when it is appointed. If the Honorable Member feels that it is necessary to have a separate law I have no objection.

2nd Appointed Member (Noll) remarked: Mr. Chairman. I agree with 1st Member for Frederiksted Town (Coulter). It seems to me that the automobile law would be a separate law, but going further than that, I do not see the need of police regulations; you can call this chapter by its proper name. It is certainly repulsive to me to be incorporating regulations in our new Code of Laws.
