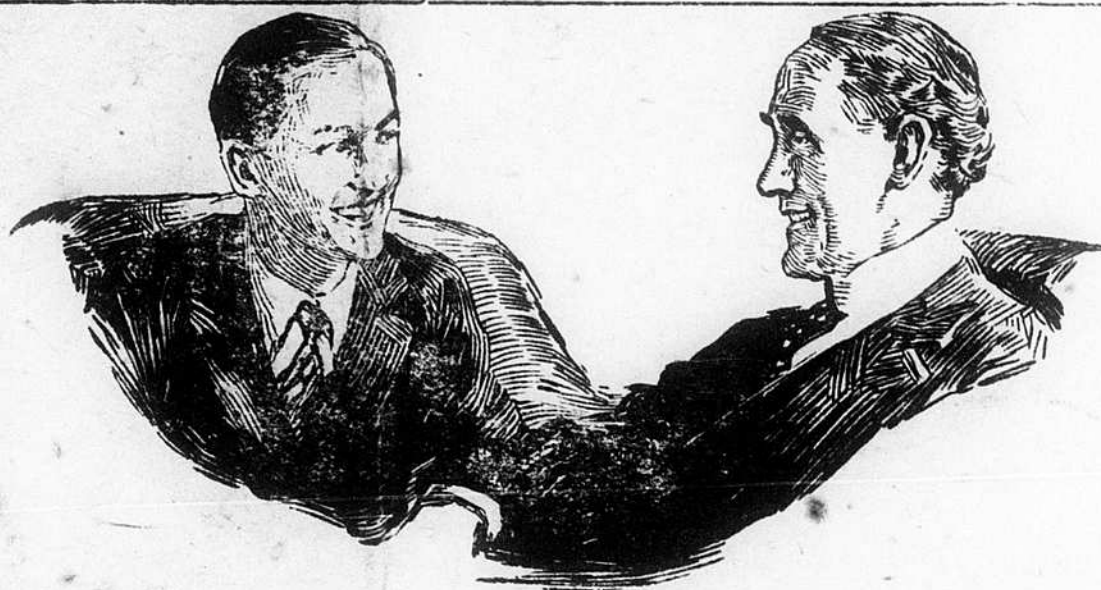
London, Sept. 23rd.—The Geneva conference of the Entente Premiers at which the new representatives of Germany were to sit with the Allied States men to make a decision about the German indemnity has been indefinitely postponed. The action was taken at the request of France who insisted that each time a conference has been held the Germans have been permitted to unload some of the obligations imposed on them by the treaty of Versailles.

New York, Sept. 22nd.—While the latest developments today in the Wall Street explosion pointed to an accident rather than a plot, news despatched from other cities indicated that an epidemic of bombs threats has broken out throughout the country. Cleveland, Boston, New Bedford, Trenton, and New York were among cities which reported anonymous messages of dire misfortune. Although the authorities profess to regard these messages as the work of some practical joker or crank nevertheless in every instance extra precautions were taken. The fact that the New York customs house still stands unshaken after the fake warning of the explosion to have occurred yesterday did not cause either Federal or local authorities to relax their vigilance.

Washington, Sept. 22nd.—The capture by the forces of General Wrangel of the towns of Aled and Rovsk on the Dnieper river and about 10,000 prisoners was reported to the United States Department today in advices from Constantinople. Wrangel's forces took 24 guns, several hundred machine guns, five armoured cars and a large amount of supplies, the despatch added.
