PROCEEDINGS OF THE COLONIAL COUNCIL FOR ST. CROIX.

(Continued from Saturday's Avis.)

Election of a Vice-Chairman.

17 voting tickets were handed in, one was blank.

3rd Member for Christiansted Country District (Robt. W. Skeoch) received 8 votes, 2nd Member for Christiansted Town (Canegata) 7 votes and 1st Appointed Member (Coulter) received one vote.

As none had absolute majority vote, a new free vote was taken.

17 voting tickets were handed in.

3rd Member for Christiansted Country District (Robt. W. Skeoch) and 2nd Member for Christiansted Town (Canegata) re-

ceived 8 votes respectively and 1st Appointed Member (Coulter) received 1 vote.

There being a tie vote between 3rd Member for Christiansted Country District (Robt. W. Skeoch) and 2nd Member for Christiansted Town (Canegata) a new free vote had to be taken.

17 voting tickets were handed in, one was blank.

2nd Member for Christiansted Town (Canegata) and 3rd Member for Christiansted Country District (Robt. W. Skeoch) received 8 votes respectively.

2nd Member for Christiansted Town (Canegata) and 3rd Member for Christiansted Country District (Robt. W. Skeoch) having secured the equal number of votes the question of the election of a Vice-Chairman was, in accordance with Paragraph 19 of the Rules of Business, decided by the age of the parties, and 3rd Member for Christiansted Country District (Robt. W. Skeoch) being the elder of the two was declared Vice-Chairman of the Council.

Election of a Secretary.

17 voting tickets were handed in, one was blank and one was invalid.

Elected was 2nd Member for Christiansted Town (Canegata) with 13 votes.

3rd Appointed Member (Armstrong) and 3rd Member for Christiansted Town (Alexander) received 1 vote respectively.

2nd Member for Christiansted Town (Canegata) remarked: Mr. Chairman. I beg to thank the Council for the honor conferred upon me, but I ask permission to decline.

The Chairman: No chance for consideration?

2nd Member for Christiansted Town (Canegata): Absolutely none.

The Chairman then asked members to prepare their voting tickets for the election of a Secretary.

12 voting tickets were handed in, one was blank.

4th Member for Frederiksted Country District (Andersen) received 4 votes, 3rd Appointed Member (Armstrong) and 1st Member for Christiansted Town (Alexander) 2 votes respectively and 3rd Member for Christiansted Town (Alexander), 1st Appointed Member (Coulter) and 2nd Appointed Member (Noll) received 1 vote respectively.

As none had absolute majority vote a new vote was taken.

15 voting tickets were handed in.

Elected was 4th Member for Frederiksted Country District (Andersen) with 9 votes.

3rd Appointed Member (Armstrong) and 3rd Member for Christiansted Town (Alexander) received 2 votes respectively, and 1st Appointed Member (Coulter) and 3rd Member for Frederiksted Country District (M. M. Skeoch) received one vote respectively.

4th Member for Frederiksted Country District (Andersen) remarked: Mr. Chairman. I understand that there is an unwritten rule that the Secretary to the Council should be a member residing in Christiansted, and for that reason I beg to tender my resignation. Furthermore, I have a record for being a late-comer to the meetings of the Council.

The Chairman in reply to the last speaker said, With reference to your remarks that the Secretary to the Council should be a resident member of Christiansted Town, I can state that a former holder of this office for a number of years did not reside in this town. However, cannot be compelled to serve if you have no desire to do so.

A new voting was ordered and 12 voting tickets were handed in for the election of a Secretary.

3rd Member for Christiansted Town (Alexander) received 4 votes, 3rd Appointed Member (Armstrong) 3 votes, 2nd Appointed Member (Noll) 2 votes and 5th Appointed Member (McIntosh), 1st Member for Christiansted Country District (Jessen) and 1st Appointed Member (Coulter) received 1 vote each.

As none had absolute majority vote a new vote was taken.

10 voting tickets were handed in.

3rd Appointed Member (Armstrong) received 4 votes, 3rd Member for Christiansted Town (Alexander) 3 votes and 2nd Member for Frederiksted Country District (Curry), 3rd Member for said District (M. M. Skeoch) and 2nd Member for Christiansted Country District (Berg) received 1 vote each.

As none had absolute majority vote a new vote had to be taken between 3rd Appointed Member (Armstrong) and 3rd Member for Christiansted Town (Alexander).

15 voting tickets were handed in, one was blank.

3rd Member for Christiansted Town (Alexander) and 3rd Appointed Member (Armstrong) received 7 votes each.
